

Preschool Kids Church Leader

Position Description

Purpose

Our goal at WEC is to **make and mature disciples of Jesus**. This means in kids church we want to see our children coming to know and love Jesus and sharing this good news with their friends and family. We want to make and mature young disciples of Jesus! We do this by prayerfully teaching and modelling the gospel to children, pointing them to Jesus as Saviour and Lord and supporting parents in their role as primary shepherds.

Brief Description

The Preschool Kids Church leader is responsible for teaching a kids church class to preschool aged children (aged 2 to 5, not yet at school) during the WEC 9am service. They will do this with a co-leader. Children commence with parents in the 9am service and following the Kids talk, parents will bring their children outside the main entry doors of the church hall where they will meet their Preschool kids church leaders. Leaders will then take the children to the designated classroom for their kids church lesson.

Detailed Description

The Preschool kids church leader's main responsibilities are outlined in the 'Serving Guide – Preschool Kids Church'.

Expectations

- Team members will read the provided Preschool lesson plan prior to teaching the lesson so they are prepared and ready to teach
- Team members will be part of the team for the year (not limited to that time) and are encouraged to review their participation in this ministry at the end of the calendar year
- Team members will complete the teaching role on the dates they are assigned on the WEC Roster. Where unavailable the team member will try to swap with another team member. This is most effectively completed via the What's App WEC Preschool kids church team group chat. When a swap is made please;
 - text your Preschool Kids Church Team Leader
 - forward the reminder SMS received on the Friday before a Sunday service to the team member who agreed to swap
- Team members will be attending a Sunday service regularly
- Team members will read and follow the WEC Guidelines Serving in children's and youth ministry'

- The team members are required to adhere to WEC Safe Church policy, agree with the WEC Leaders Code of Conduct, have a working with children check number and the required safe ministry training.
- Team members will attend meetings/trainings for the Preschool kids church team.
- Team members will be committed to discipling the children in their group, prayerfully teaching and modelling the gospel to the children in their care.
- Team members will advise the Preschool kids church team leader when equipment for their role is in need of repair or missing.
- Team members will understand and adhere to the WEC WHS procedure for incidents & hazards. If an incident occurs during set up an 'Incident form' needs to be completed and provided to the Preschool kids church Team Leader. If the team member identifies a hazard/near miss during set up a 'Hazard/Near Miss form' needs to be completed and provided to the Preschool kids church Team Leader.
- Team members will take an interest in praying for other members of their team and church family.
- In the event of any issues that arise in the course of serving in this ministry, the team member is to bring them to their team leader. If this is not possible, the team member can bring their concern to the Director of Kids and Youth.

Accountability

Preschool kids church leaders are to work under, support and accept the authority of Preschool kids church Team Leader.
